KEYWORD AND SUMMARY AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

INSURANCE DEPARTMENT. Provides for a minority hiring survey by the division of minority affairs in the Department of Insurance. (8/1/13)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Adds provision that the survey's exemption from public records does not apply with respect to the aggregated number of minorities hired and the positions for which minorities are hired.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

<u>Present law</u> provides for a division of minority affairs within the Dept. of Insurance with duties to include assisting in the coordination of activities of the department's Advisory Committee on Equal Opportunity.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the division to conduct a survey of insurers' hiring and contracting policies and practices in relation to minorities.

Requires that the survey, data, and responses are not a public record as defined in the Public Records Law and are exempt from disclosure except with respect to the aggregated number of minorities hired and the positions for which minorities are hired.
