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WEAPONS/FIREARMS RE NO IMPACT See Note Repeals provisions of law regarding the possession and transfer of certain firearms

<u>Present law</u> includes and defines certain firearms and firearms equipped with certain accessories for inclusion within a category of firearms for purposes of certain provisions of law governing the transfer of weapons. <u>Present federal law</u> provisions (26 U.S.C. 5812) and regulations of the Federal Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF Form 4) require both federal and local law enforcement approval as part of federal requirement to transfer a firearm. <u>Present law</u> requires the same approval resulting in similar or identical information being collected on both the state and federal level to transfer certain firearms. <u>Present law</u> prohibits the possession or transfer of certain firearm types without prior approval of the Department of Public Safety and provides for seizure and forefeiture for noncompliance. <u>Proposed law</u> repeals present law. <u>Present law</u> provides that no person shall possess, or transfer any firearm which has not been registered or transferred in accordance with present law. <u>Proposed law</u> changes <u>present law</u> to prohibit the possession and purchase of a firearm that has not been registered or transferred in accordance with <u>present law</u>.
