| 9 | 33:2588 is hereby enacted to read as follows: |
| 10 | §2391. Applicability |
| 11 | A. This Part applies shall apply to any city having a population exceeding |
| 12 | one hundred thousand according to the latest regular federal decennial census for |
| 13 | which the official figures have been made public. |
| 14 | B. This Part does shall not apply to positions which are covered by Part II |
| 15 | of this Chapter. |
| 16 | C. In the event that the civil service of any city pursuant to this Part is |
| 17 | determined by a final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction to not be |
| 18 | subject to this Part, the civil service of the city shall be subject to the |
| 19 | jurisdiction of the state civil service system. The provisions of this Subsection |
| 20 | shall not apply to any municipality with a population of not less than two |
| 21 | hundred fifteen thousand persons and not more than three hundred thousand |

| 24 | §2471. Applicability |
| 25 | A. This Part applies to any municipality which operates a regularly paid fire |

and police department and which has a population of not less than thirteen thousand nor more than two hundred fifty thousand according to the latest regular federal **decennial** census for which the official figures have been made public.

B. In the event that the civil service of any municipality pursuant to this Part is determined by a final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction to not be subject to this Part, the civil service of the municipality shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the state civil service system. The provisions of this Subsection shall not apply to any municipality with a population of not less than two hundred fifteen thousand persons and not more than three hundred thousand persons according to the latest federal decennial census.

§2588. Determination that certain constitutional provisions are not applicable to city

In the event that the civil service of any city pursuant to the city civil service provisions of Part I of Article X of the Constitution of Louisiana is determined by a final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction to not be subject to such provisions, the civil service of the city shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the state civil service system.

§2591. System of classified service

A. There is created in every municipality having a population between 250,000 and 500,000 two hundred fifty thousand and five hundred thousand a classified civil service embracing the positions of employment, the officers and the employees of the fire and police services. The classified civil service herein provided for shall be established, operated and governed in all respects solely by the provisions of Section 15.1 of Article XIV of the Constitution of Louisiana.

B. In the event that the civil service of any municipality pursuant to this

Part is determined by a final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction to

not be subject to this Part, the civil service of the municipality shall be subject

to the jurisdiction of the state civil service system. The provisions of this

Subsection shall not apply to any municipality with a population of not less than
two hundred fifteen thousand persons and not more than three hundred
thousand persons according to the latest federal decennial census.
