Requires the secretary of state to take action necessary to allow certain classes of voters to vote absentee

The proposed legislation requires the Secretary of State to allow members of the U. S. services and persons residing outside the U. S. to vote absentee at all times, not only during a period of declared emergency. The proposed legislation requires the Secretary of State to allow registered voters who are unable to vote during early voting or at the polling place on election day due to out-of-state work responsibilities relating to a declared emergency to vote absentee.

Implementation of this legislation will require some internal policy and procedural changes for the Secretary of State and is anticipated to have a minimal fiscal impact that will be provided for with existing resources. The agency will be required to update its written document "2012 Registrar of Voters Procedures for Emergency Voting Electronically for Military and Overseas Voters". The agency will update the document to include the new absentee voter class for emergency workers who are out-of-state during a declared emergency.
