Morrell (SB 213) Act No. 126

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> regarding provisional appointments, but prohibits a classified employee of the New Orleans Police Department who has been temporarily appointed to a provisional appointment from being eligible for any benefits which are to accrue based upon the promotion, or increase in salary.

<u>New law</u> provides that notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, no additional benefits shall accrue or be earned from compensation above the normal rate of pay for a classified employee of the New Orleans Police Department who has been appointed to a temporary executive level assignment within the department and for which such employee receives special assignment pay.

New law provides for definitions.

Effective August 1, 2013.
