SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 201

BY SENATOR NEVERS

MOTOR VEHICLES. Requests office of motor vehicles to study issues relative to public tag agents issuing driver's license renewals and other services to improve service to citizens.

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To urge and request the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor  
3 vehicles, to study the issues relative to public tag agents issuing driver's license  
4 renewals as well as other office of motor vehicles services which may improve  
5 service delivery to citizens of Louisiana, and to submit a written report of its findings  
6 and recommendations to the Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways, and  
7 Public Works not later than thirty days prior to the convening of the 2014 Regular  
8 Session of the Legislature.

9 WHEREAS, public tag agents provide certain office of motor vehicle services in a  
10 convenient, economic, and timely manner; and

11 WHEREAS, expansion of the office of motor vehicle services which public tag  
12 agents are authorized to provide such as issuing driver's license renewals as well as other  
13 services may improve service delivery to the citizens of Louisiana.

14 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana  
15 does hereby urge and request the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of  
16 motor vehicles, to study the issues relative to public tag agents issuing driver's license  
17 renewals as well as other office of motor vehicles services which may improve service  
18 delivery to citizens of Louisiana, and to submit a written report of its findings and

1 recommendations to the Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works  
2 not later than thirty days prior to the convening of the 2014 Regular Session of the  
3 Legislature.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be transmitted  
5 to the deputy secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, public safety  
6 services, and to the commissioner of the Department of Public Safety and Correction, office  
7 of motor vehicles.
