5	WHEREAS, Major League Soccer is a growing and dynamic professional sports
6	association that conducts soccer at its highest level in North America; and
7	WHEREAS, Major League Soccer does not currently have any franchises located in
8	the southeastern section of the United States; and
9	WHEREAS, Louisiana has a thriving and growing youth soccer movement with an
10	estimated forty thousand participants on an annual basis; and
11	WHEREAS, Louisiana has a strong tradition of supporting its sports teams; and
12	WHEREAS, the placement of an existing Major League Soccer franchise or
13	expansion team in Louisiana would create jobs and attract soccer enthusiasts from across the
14	nation to Louisiana.
15	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
16	does hereby urge and request the Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and
17	International Affairs to study the feasibility of attracting an existing Major League Soccer
18	franchise or expansion team to locate in Louisiana.
