COMMENDATIONS: Commends the 2013 International Legislative Drafting participants and welcomes them to the state capitol

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend the 2013 International Legislative Drafting Institute participants and to
3 welcome them to the Louisiana State Capitol.

4 WHEREAS, The Public Law Center, a joint venture of the Loyola and Tulane law
5 schools, launched the International Legislative Drafting Institute in 1995 in response to
6 increasing global demand for training of legislative drafters; and

7 WHEREAS, the Institute is a two-week summer program that responds to the
8 worldwide demand on legislative drafters for new laws to support the emergence of free
9 market economies and democratic forms of government and draws together diverse domestic
10 and international faculty members experienced in the legislative process; and

11 WHEREAS, this year's institute will be held from June 10th through the 21st and is
12 the nineteenth edition of the institute; and

13 WHEREAS, more than five hundred participants from more than ninety-five
14 countries around the globe have graduated from the Institute, and staff members of The
15 Public Law Center have conducted training events in Europe, Asia, Africa, and the
16 Caribbean; and

17 WHEREAS, Institute participants have traveled to Baton Rouge to spend a day at the
18 Louisiana State Capitol, where they get a firsthand look at representative democracy; and

19 WHEREAS, staff members of the Louisiana Legislature have a long tradition of
20 assisting with the training of Institute participants, both in the classroom and during their site
21 visit to Baton Rouge; and

1 WHEREAS, the legislature recognizes the critical importance of the International
2 Legislative Drafting Institute and the lessons it imparts, the tremendous achievement of the
3 individual students in being selected by their home jurisdictions to participate, and the hard
4 work that the Institute requires of its participants, who merit a special measure of
5 commendation.

6 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
7 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend the 2013 International Legislative Drafting
8 Institute participants and the jurisdictions they represent for their investment of time, effort,
9 and resources in the improvement of their governments in general and of legislative drafting
10 in particular and does hereby welcome them with great pride and honor to the Louisiana
11 State Capitol.
