SCHOOLS. Authorizes the chairman of the Senate Committee on Education to appoint a subcommittee to study issues affecting school environment.

A RESOLUTION

2	To authorize the chairman of the Senate Committee on Education, with the approval of the
3	President of the Senate, to appoint a subcommittee of the standing committee for the
4	purpose of studying and receiving testimony regarding issues affecting the school
5	environment, including school violence.
6	WHEREAS, studies show that there is a direct correlation between the quality of the
7	school environment and student academic achievement and success and every student
8	deserves a school climate that is conducive to learning; and
9	WHEREAS, violence, or the perceived threat of violence, creates anxiety among
10	students and can have a significant negative impact upon attendance, academic performance,
11	student behavior, and ultimately, graduation rates; and
12	WHEREAS, state law and State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education
13	(BESE) policy require each public elementary and secondary school to adopt a student code
14	of conduct to which all students must adhere and the school must enforce; and
15	WHEREAS, state law and BESE policy also require each public school to prepare
16	and implement a school crisis management and response plan to address school safety and
17	the incidence of violence at schools, on school buses, and at school-related activities and
18	respond effectively to such incidents; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the state's public schools be safe havens for teaching
and learning and that every student and teacher be provided a school environment in which
they are free from fear of physical harm throughout each and every school day.
