AMENDMENT NO. 2

In Senate Floor Amendment No. 5 proposed by Senator Donahue and adopted by the Senate on June 3, 2013, on page 16, delete lines 28 through 34

1. Increase (decrease) means of finance as follows: State General Fund (Direct) by \$108,543,517; Interagency Transfers by \$4,122,654; Fees and Self-generated Revenues by \$42,630,100; Statutory Dedications by \$392,871,246; Federal Funds by \$2,014,737.

Report rejects Senate amendments which would have:

1. Senate Committee Amendment would have added a Medicaid appropriation; Senate Floor Amendment would have deleted the Senate Committee Amendment.

Report amends the bill to:

1. Increases appropriations out of statutory dedications by \$975,483. Decreases appropriations out of Fees and Self-generated Revenues by (\$240,000).
