AN ACT

2	To enact R.S. 9:2621, relative to the Louisiana Uniform Electronic Transactions Act; to
3	provide for an online certification; to provide terms, conditions and requirements;
4	and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 9:2621 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§2621. Certification of electronic records
8	A. Notwithstanding any provision of the law to the contrary, when a
9	governmental agency offers online applications through an internet interface
10	for any license or permit, and the particular law for such license or permit
11	requires a sworn application for such license or permit, the governmental
12	agency may accept an online certification from the applicant in lieu of the sworn
13	application.
14	B.(1) The online certification shall require the applicant to certify that
15	all of the information and documentation the applicant submits via the online
16	application through an internet interface shall be true and correct, and that the
17	applicant has not used a false or fictitious name in such application, and that the
18	applicant has not knowingly made a false statement or has not knowingly
19	concealed any material fact or otherwise committed any fraud in any such
20	application for a license or permit.
21	(2) Use by a governmental agency of any online certification provisions
22	included in a nationwide online licensing or registration system shall be
23	permissible and deemed in compliance with Paragraph (1) of this Subsection.

1 C. A governmental agency that elects to accept online applications 2 through an internet interface, and thus accepting an online certification in lieu 3 of a sworn application, shall promulgate such rules and regulations in 4 accordance with R.S. 9:2619 and the Administrative Procedure Act as are 5 necessary to implement such online certification. D. The acceptance of an online application with the certification 6 7 authorized by this Section, in lieu of the sworn application otherwise required by law, shall not result in, or create any liability on the part of the state or the 8 9 governmental agency. 10 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 11 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 12 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 13 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 14 effective on the day following such approval.
