## **ACT No. 169**

HOUSE BILL NO. 722 (Substitute for House Bill No. 313 by Representative Honore)

## BY REPRESENTATIVE HONORE AND SENATOR BROOME

| 1  | AN ACT   |
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| 2  | To enact R.S. 15:85.4, relative to posting of criminal bonds; to provide for an additional fee |
| 3  | to be assessed for criminal bonds posted in the city court of Baton Rouge; to provide          |
| 4  | for collection of fees by the constable of the Baton Rouge City Court; to provide for          |
| 5  | allocation of funds to the constable's fund; to provide for use of funds for the               |
| 6  | operational expenses of the constable's office; to provide for a refund of the fee in          |
| 7  | certain cases; and to provide for related matters.   |
| 8  | Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:   |
| 9  | Section 1. R.S. 15:85.4 is hereby enacted to read as follows:                                  |
| 10 | §85.4. Posting of criminal bonds; Baton Rouge city constable's office; additional fee          |
| 11 | assessed   |
| 12 | A. An additional fee of thirty-five dollars shall be assessed for every criminal               |
| 13 | bond posted in the city court of Baton Rouge. This fee shall be in addition to any             |
| 14 | other fees or fines provided by law. Any person seeking release by means of a                  |
| 15 | criminal bond, or his designated representative, shall pay the fee to the constable for        |
| 16 | the Baton Rouge City Court who shall deposit the funds in the constable's fund for             |
| 17 | the city court of Baton Rouge.   |
| 18 | B. The monies collected pursuant to the provisions of Subsection A of this                     |
| 19 | Section shall be used to supplement the operational expenses of the Baton Rouge                |
| 20 | City constable's office. The expenditure of the funds shall be at the sole discretion          |
| 21 | of the constable of the court.   |
| 22 | C. If the prosecuting attorney declines to prosecute a person who has paid                     |
| 23 | this fee or the prosecution results in an acquittal, dismissal, or granting of a motion        |
| 24 | to quash, then the person who paid the fee shall be entitled to a refund after                 |

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submitting a request for a refund of the fee to the city court within thirty days of the final disposition of the case. The constable's office shall refund the fee within thirty days after receiving notice of the court's order granting the request for a refund.

D. The assessment and disposition of any funds pursuant to this Section shall not affect the responsibilities of the city and parish governing authority provided by law for the financing of the constable's office of the city court of Baton Rouge.
