Authorizes DPS&C to sell bulletproof vests to other law enforcement agencies

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<u>Present law</u> requires the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to provide bulletproof vests to every peace officer in the state provided that funds are appropriated for this purpose. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that to the extent that funds are not appropriated for this purpose, DPS may make available for purchase to law enforcement agencies bulletproof vests no longer utilized by the department for which the manufacturer warranty has expired, provides that such sale be conducted pursuant to the rules and regulations of the Louisiana Property Assistance Agency (LPAA), and provides that the State of Louisiana, its agencies and assigns shall be immune to any liability relating to or resulting from the purchase, issuance, or failure of bulletproof vests transferred pursuant to proposed law.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. The LPAA currently receives surplus and expired vests from state agencies as part of the state surplus property program. Because these bulletproof vests are generally past the expiration date, the LPAA disposes of the vests in accordance with recommended practices. Proposed law will allow the LPAA to sell vests with expired warranties to other law enforcement agencies.
