## SENATE BILL NO. 240

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 13:1381.7, relative to courts and judicial procedure; to provide relative to the
3	Orleans Parish Criminal District Court; to provide relative to the office of the clerk
4	of court; to provide relative to funding; to provide an effective date; and to provide
5	for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 13:1381.7 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§1381.7. Clerk of the Orleans Parish Criminal District Court
9	A. The legislature finds that adequate funding of the office of Clerk of
10	the Criminal District Court for the parish of Orleans is necessary for the
11	efficient performance of the powers and duties required of a judicial officer of
12	the state. Pursuant to the exercise of the police power of the state, actions for
13	obtaining adequate funding are necessary to promote judicial efficiency and to
14	protect and promote the lives, health, morals, comfort, and general welfare of
15	people as a whole. The amounts to be appropriated and paid by the city of New
16	Orleans for expenses, including salaries and maintenance of constitutional
17	officers, their deputies, subordinates, and employees shall not be reduced by the
18	city of New Orleans without the consent of the legislature.
19	<b>B.</b> The legislature further finds that state statutes mandating payment
20	by the city of New Orleans to the state's employees and officers of the Clerk for
21	the Criminal District Court for the parish of Orleans constitute a valid exercise
22	of state's police power, and such statutes do not violate the provisions of the
23	Louisiana Constitution of 1921 or the Louisiana Constitution of 1974.

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1	C. Nothing contained in this Act shall be construed as giving to the city
2	of New Orleans any rights, powers, authority, or jurisdiction over any
3	<u>constitutional officers, their deputies, employees, subordinates, or over any state</u>
4	or district officers, their deputies, subordinates, or employees.
5	Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall become effective on July 1, 2013.
