AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 40:1300.57, relative to criminal history checks on nonlicensed persons and 3 licensed ambulance personnel; to provide with respect to an authorized agency; to provide for the application and requirements for approval as an authorized agency; 4 5 and to provide for related matters. 6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 7 Section 1. R.S. 40:1300.57 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 8 §1300.57. Application to be approved as an authorized agency 9 A. An individual or business entity seeking approval as an authorized 10 agency shall submit an application to the Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information along with the following documents to prove the 11 individual's or business entity's qualifications: 12 (1) The applicant must be currently licensed in the state of Louisiana as 13 14 a private investigator or detective by the Louisiana State Board of Private Investigator Examiners as evidenced by current and valid licensure issued by 15 16 the Louisiana State Board of Private Investigator Examiners, or an individual 17 employed by a business entity domiciled in the state of Louisiana and registered and in good standing with the secretary of state at the time of application whose 18 19 primary source of business is background screenings.

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1	(2) The applicant must not currently be charged by bill of information
2	or under indictment for, or have been convicted of, any felony offense in this
3	state or any other jurisdiction and shall submit to a background investigation
4	to determine that this requirement is met.
5	(3) The applicant shall be domiciled in the state of Louisiana and shall
6	present proof of qualification to do business within the state of Louisiana, as
7	evidenced by a valid certificate of authority issued by the secretary of state, and
8	designation of an agent for service of process as required by law. If the
9	applicant is operating as a sole proprietorship, a current and valid occupational
10	license shall be presented.
11	(4) The applicant shall execute a written agreement whereby he agrees
12	to maintain the confidentiality of any and all information provided to it by the
13	Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information pursuant to R.S.
14	40:1300.51 et seq., abide by all applicable laws, rules and regulations pertaining
15	to receipt and use of criminal history information, cooperate in any auditing
16	procedure conducted by the Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and
17	Information, and inform the Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and
18	Information in writing of any known violations regarding the use of criminal
19	history information he receives.
20	B. Upon receipt of a completed application for approval as an
21	authorized agency, the Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and
22	Information shall review the application and conduct whatever investigation it
23	deems necessary to verify the information. Upon completion of this review, the
24	Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information shall inform the
25	applicant in writing of its approval or denial of the application and, in the case
26	of denial, the reasons for such denial.
27	C. Each authorized agency shall maintain the eligibility requirements
28	to be approved as an authorized agency. Each authorized agency shall notify
29	the Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information in writing of

a change in its qualification requirements within fifteen days of the change.

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1	Failure to continue to maintain the eligibility requirements shall result in
2	cancellation of approval as an authorized agency.
