HOUSE BILL NO. 678

BY REPRESENTATIVE FANNIN

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds and to make certain reductions in appropriations from certain sources
3 to be allocated to designated agencies and purposes in specific amounts for the
4 making of supplemental appropriations and reductions for said agencies and
5 purposes for Fiscal Year 2012-2013; to provide for an effective date; and to provide
6 for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. The commissioner of administration is hereby authorized and directed to
9 reduce the State General Fund (Direct) appropriations and the number of authorized
10 positions contained in Act No. 13 of the 2012 Regular Session of the Legislature for the
11 following agencies in the specified amounts as a result of Executive Order No. BJ 2012-25 -
12 Expenditure Freeze issued on December 14, 2012. Reductions are denoted in parentheses.
