

Existing law defines "employee" for purposes of membership in the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System (MPERS).

New law adds to the definition of "employee" any legal investigator employed by the East Baton Rouge parish attorney's office who receives supplemental state pay and who transferred into the system as a result of the merger agreement between the city-parish and the system on Feb. 26, 2000, thus making these individuals eligible for membership in the MPERS system. New law further provides that any such member with a break in service after the merger will retain MPERS membership or retiree status only to the extent of his deferred vested benefit accrued until the break in service.

Provides that the Act shall be applied retroactively and prospectively.

Effective June 30, 2013.
