

Existing law provides that the Wildlife and Fisheries Commission consist of seven members to be appointed by the governor to represent certain industries and at large from the state.

New law retains existing law and specifies that two of the at-large members must each be electors from north of a line created by the northern boundary of the parishes of Beauregard, Allen, Evangeline, Avoyelles, and Pointe Coupee.

New law becomes effective if, as, and when the amendment to the constitution proposed by HB No. 426 of the 2013 R.S. is adopted at a statewide election and becomes effective.
