Armes (HB 503) Act No. 198

<u>Existing law</u> provides that the Wildlife and Fisheries Commission consist of seven members to be appointed by the governor to represent certain industries and at large from the state.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and specifies that two of the at-large members must each be electors from north of a line created by the northern boundary of the parishes of Beauregard, Allen, Evangeline, Avoyelles, and Pointe Coupee.

<u>New law</u> becomes effective if, as, and when the amendment to the constitution proposed by HB No. 426 of the 2013 R.S. is adopted at a statewide election and becomes effective.
