## **Mack (HB 90)**

<u>Existing law</u> requires the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to provide bulletproof vests to every peace officer in the state of La. provided that funds are appropriated for this purpose.

<u>New law</u> further provides that to the extent that funds are not appropriated for this purpose, DPS&C may make available for purchase to law enforcement agencies bulletproof vests no longer utilized by the department for which the manufacturer warranty has expired.

<u>New law</u> further provides that any purchase shall be conducted pursuant to rules or regulations adopted by the La. Property Assistance Agency.

<u>New law</u> provides that the state of La., its agencies and assigns, including but not limited to DPS&C, shall be immune from any liability relating to or resulting from the purchase, issuance, or failure of bulletproof vests transferred pursuant to <u>new law</u>.

Effective August 1, 2013.
