

Existing law provides a mechanism whereby any parent may relinquish the care of an infant to the state in safety, anonymity, and without fear of prosecution.

Prior law defined an infant as a child not previously subjected to abuse or neglect, who is not more than 30 days old.

New law changes the age requirement in the definition of an infant from "not more than 30 days old" to "not more than 60 days old".

Effective August 1, 2013.
