INSURERS. Mandates inclusion of lymphedema treatment as an option in health insurance coverage. (8/1/14)

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 22:1025.1, relative to group, blanket, and association health insurance; to
3	mandate inclusion of coverage for the treatment of lymphedema as an option in
4	certain policies; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 22:1025.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§1025.1. Group, blanket, and association health insurance, treatment for
8	<u>lymphedema</u>
9	A. Any group, blanket, or association health insurance policy issued
10	under R.S. 22:1000 shall include as an option to be exercised by the
11	policyholder, as defined therein, covered benefits for the treatment of
12	lymphedema, rendered or prescribed by a physician licensed in this state,
13	received in any licensed hospital or in any other public or private facility
14	authorized, to provide lymphedema treatment, including multilayer
15	compression bandaging systems and custom or standard fit gradient
16	compression garments.
17	B. Any insurer who, on August 1, 2014, has group, blanket, or association

1	<u>health insurance policies in force shall convert such existing policies to conform</u>
2	to the provisions of this Section on or before the renewal dates.
3	<u>C.</u> The provisions of this Section shall not apply to limited benefit health
4	insurance policies or contracts authorized to be issued in this state.

Broome (SB 57)

<u>Proposed law</u> requires any group, blanket, or association health insurance policy in effect on August 1, 2014, or issued after that date to provide the policyholder with an option to include benefits for the treatment of lymphedema including multilayer compression bandaging systems and custom or standard fit gradient compression garments. Excludes limited benefit health insurance policies or contracts.

Effective August 1, 2014.
