ELECTIONS: Provides for an automatic recount in elections when the number of absentee by mail and early voting ballots could make a difference in the outcome of the election

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 18:1313(J)(2)(a) and (b) and to repeal R.S. 18:1313(J)(2)(d),
3	relative to elections; to provide relative to recounts of absentee by mail and early
4	voting ballots; to provide for an automatic recount under certain circumstances; to
5	provide for procedures; to provide relative to the duties of certain election officials
6	relative to such recount; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 18:1313(J)(2)(a) and (b) are hereby amended and reenacted to read
9	as follows:
10	§1313. Tabulation and counting of absentee by mail and early voting ballots
11	* * *

14	(2)(a) Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph (1) of this Subsection,
15	if the number of absentee by mail and early voting ballots cast for all candidates for
16	an office or for and against a proposition could make a difference in the outcome of
17	the election for such office, upon the written request of a candidate for such office,
18	the board shall recount the absentee by mail ballots by hand or scanning equipment
19	and early voting ballots electronically, unless paper ballots were used for early
20	voting and in such case, the ballots shall be recounted by hand for such office.

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CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

1	(b) All recounts of absentee by mail and early voting ballots shall be held at
2	10:00 a.m. or following the reinspection of voting machines on the fifth day after the
3	election and at any time ordered by a court of competent jurisdiction. If the fifth day
4	after the election falls on a holiday or weekend, such recount shall be held on the
5	next working day at 10:00 a.m. or following the reinspection of voting machines.
6	Any written request for recount of absentee by mail and early voting ballots shall be
7	filed with the clerk of court. The deadline for filing a request for recount of absentee
8	by mail and early voting ballots shall be the last working day prior to the date of the
9	recount. Immediately upon receiving any request, the The clerk of court shall
10	prominently post in his office a notice of the time and place where the absentee by
11	mail and early voting ballots will be recounted and the name of the candidate
12	requesting the recount.

14	Section 2. R.S. 18:1313(J)(2)(d) is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Abstract: Provides for an automatic recount in elections when the number of absentee by mail and early voting ballots could make a difference in the outcome of the election.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 18:1313) provides relative to the tabulation and counting of absentee by mail and early voting ballots. Provides that if the number of absentee by mail and early voting ballots cast for all candidates for an office could make a difference in the outcome of the election for such office, the parish board of election supervisors shall recount the absentee by mail ballots. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the recount only takes place if requested by a candidate for such office. Requires the request to be filed with the clerk. Provides deadlines. Provides that the candidate requesting the recount shall be responsible for all reasonable costs associated with such recount which shall be payable to the clerk of court. Provides for the method of payment. <u>Proposed law</u> repeals <u>present law</u>. Applies <u>proposed law</u> to proposition elections in addition to candidate elections.
