<u>Present law</u> provides that a political candidate not registered with a political party will list "no party" on the notice of candidacy and primary or general election ballot. Prohibits a political party which declares its name solely to be "Independent" or "the Independent Party" from being recognized.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows a political candidate not registered with a political party to list "independent" on the notice of candidacy and primary or general election ballot. Allows for the recognition of a political party that declares its name solely to be "Independent" or "the Independent Party".
