COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS: Provides relative to single business entities

AN ACT

2	To enact R.S. 12:1702, relative to commercial regulations; provides relative to separate
3	juridical personalities of affiliated business organizations; to provide for definitions;
4	and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 12:1702 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§1702. Business organizations: juridical personalities
8	A. The separate juridical personality of an affiliated business organization
9	may not be disregarded as between the affiliated organization, except on grounds that
10	would justify disregarding the separate juridical personality of a business
11	organization, as between the organization and a natural person.
12	B. For purposes of this Section, the term "business organization" means a
13	business corporation, nonprofit corporation, limited liability company, partnership,
14	or other form of business organization that is treated as a juridical person or legal
15	entity pursuant to the laws of the state or country under which it is incorporated or
16	organized.

Broadwater HB No. 351

Abstract: Provides relative to single business entities and affiliated juridical personalities.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a separate juridical personality of an affiliated business organization may not be disregarded, except on grounds that would justify a disregard of the juridical personality as between the organization and a natural person.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "business organization" as a business corporation, nonprofit corporation, limited liability company, partnership or other form of business organization that is treated as a juridical person or legal entity under the laws of the state or country under which it is incorporated or organized.
