INSURANCE: Repeals provisions relative to dental referral plans

1 AN ACT

2 To repeal Subpart H of Part III of Chapter 4 of Title 22 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of
3 1950, comprised of R.S. 22:1161 through 1167, relative to dental referral plans; to
4 repeal provisions relative to dental referral plans.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. Subpart H of Part III of Chapter 4 of Title 22 of the Louisiana Revised
7 Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 22:1161 through 1167, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Abstract: Repeals provisions related to dental referral plans.

Present law defines a dental referral plan as a contractual plan that provides a list of dental care providers who have agreed to provide treatment to enrollees in the plan for specific fees.

Present law requires dental referral plans to register with the commissioner of insurance and provides procedures for registration.

Present law requires renewal of registration every two years and payment of an initial registration and renewal fee of \$250.

Present law allows the imposition of a money penalty of up to \$2,500 for violations of present law.

Proposed law repeals present law.
