DIGEST

Crowe (SB 295)

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> provides that no state executive branch agency or local government agency shall share any person's personally identifiable information with another agency, private company, or anyone else without the express written permission of the person or a warrant.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> provides "personally identifiable information" means information that can be used to distinguish a person's identity, either alone or when combined with other personal or identifying information that is linked or linkable to a specific person.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> provides that the provisions of <u>proposed constitutional amendment</u> shall not prohibit the sharing of personally identifiable information between law enforcement personnel for a legal or law enforcement purpose.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> provides that any person adversely affected by the sharing of personally identifiable information in violation of <u>proposed constitutional amendment</u> shall have standing to raise its illegality in the appropriate court.

Specifies submission of the amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held on November 4, 2014.
