SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY: Amends the definition of criminal offense against a victim who is a minor to include certain convictions of stalking

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 15:541(12)(a), relative to registration and notification
3	requirements of sex offenders and child predators; to amend the definition of
4	criminal offense against a victim who is a minor; to require persons convicted of
5	such offenses to register and provide notification; to provide for application; and to
6	provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 15:541(12)(a) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§541. Definitions
10	For the purposes of this Chapter, the definitions of terms in this Section shall
11	apply:

13	(12) "Criminal offense against a victim who is a minor" for the purposes of
14	this Chapter means conviction for the perpetration or attempted perpetration of or
15	conspiracy to commit any of the following offenses:
16	(a) A violation of R.S. 14: <u>40.2</u> , 44, 44.1, 44.2, 45, 45.1, 46, or 46.1 when the
17	victim is under eighteen years of age and the defendant is not the parent of the
18	victim.

- 1 Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall apply to any person who is convicted or
- 2 who is in the custody or under the supervision of the Department of Public Safety and
- 3 Corrections on or after the effective date of this Act.

HB No. 639

Abstract: Adds persons convicted of certain offenses involving stalking to the list of persons who are required to register and provide notification as a sex offender or child predator.

<u>Present law</u> provides that persons convicted of certain sex offenses or certain criminal offenses against a victim who is a minor are required to register and provide notification.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a definition of "criminal offense against a victim who is a minor" and provides that such persons are required to register for a period of fifteen years and update his registration in person annually from the date of initial registration.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds persons convicted of the crime of stalking against a person under the age of eighteen to the definition of "criminal offense against a victim who is a minor".

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> who are convicted or who are in the custody or under the supervision of DPS&C on or after the effective date of the <u>proposed law</u>.
