SCHOOLS/DISTRICTS: Requires that the Recovery School District provide advance notice to contractors when decisions have been made to cancel contracts

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:1990(B)(1)(e), relative to the Recovery School District; to
3	provide for notice to contractors prior to canceling constracts; and to provide for
4	related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 17:1990(B)(1)(e) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as
7	follows:
8	§1990. Recovery School District; creation; governance; operation

13	(e) The school district shall not be required to utilize any selection board
14	including but not limited to the Louisiana Architects Selection Board, the Louisiana
15	Engineers Selection Board, or the Louisiana Landscape Architects Selection Board
16	when contracting for any public work or professional service, or when contracting
17	for any other service. However, the school district shall comply with all other
18	applicable provisions of Title 38 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.
19	Additionally, the school district shall give notice to a contractor ten days prior to
20	canceling any contract provided for in this Subparagraph.

Barrow HB No. 816

Abstract: Requires the Recovery School District to give a contractor 10 notice prior to cancelling a contract.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the Recovery School District is not required to use any selection board when contracting for any public work or professional service, or when contracting for any other service.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the school district shall comply with all other applicable provisions of <u>present law</u> providing for public contracts.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the school district to give notice to a contractor 10 days prior to canceling any contract provided for in <u>present law</u>.
