HOUSE BILL NO. 955

BOARDS/COMMISSIONS: Provides relative to training requirements for board members of transit authorities

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 48:236, relative to transit authorities; to provide for training for certain
3 members of board or commissions of regional transit authorities; and to provide for
4 related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 48:236 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §236. Transit authorities; training

8 A. All appointed members of a board or a commission of a regional transit
9 authority shall receive at least six hours of training either prior to taking office or no
10 later than one year from taking office. The training shall be approved by the parish
11 or municipal governing authority of the jurisdiction where the transit authority is
12 located and shall include the duties, responsibilities, ethics, and substance of the
13 position held or to be held.

14 B. The provisions of this Section shall only apply to members appointed to
15 such boards or commissions on or after January 1, 2015.

Abstract: Requires training for members of board or commissions of regional transit authorities.

Proposed law requires all appointed members of a board or a commission of a regional transit authority receive at least six hours of training either prior to taking office or no later than 1 year from taking office.

Proposed law requires the training be approved by the parish or municipal governing authority of the jurisdiction where the transit authority is located.

Proposed law provides that the training include the duties, responsibilities, ethics, and substance of the position held or to be held.

Proposed law provides that proposed law shall only apply to members appointed to such boards or commissions on or after Jan. 1, 2015.
