SCHOOLS: Provides relative to the New Orleans Center for Creative Arts (NOCCA)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 17:1970.24(B)(1)(a)(ii)(bb), relative to the New Orleans Center
3 for Creative Arts; to provide with respect to the membership of its board of directors;
4 and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 17:1970.24(B)(1)(a)(ii)(bb) is hereby amended and reenacted to read
7 as follows:

8 §1970.24. Board of directors; creation; membership; terms; powers and duties;

Abstract: Provides relative to the membership of the board of directors of the New Orleans Center for Creative Arts.

Present law provides for the creation of the New Orleans Center for Creative Arts (NOCCA). Further provides for the creation of a board of directors to be composed of thirteen members.

Present law provides that one of the members is the state superintendent of education. Proposed law authorizes the superintendent of education to appoint a designee to serve in his place; otherwise retains present law.
