HOUSE BILL NO. 972

HIGHWAYS: Designates a portion of U.S. Highway 190 in the parish of St. Tammany as "Tammany Parkway"

1 AN ACT

2 To designate a portion of U.S. Highway 190 in the city of Mandeville in St. Tammany
3 Parish as "Tammany Parkway".

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. The section of U.S. Highway 190 in the city of Mandeville in St.
6 Tammany Parish from the point of its intersection at Louisiana Highway 22, traveling north
7 until the intersection of Rogers Lane, in the city of Covington in the parish of St. Tammany
8 shall be hereinafter known and designated as "Tammany Parkway".

9 Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development or its contractors are
10 hereby directed to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this designation.

HB No. 972

Specifies that the section of U.S. Highway 190 in the city of Mandeville in St. Tammany Parish from the point of its intersection at La. Highway 22, traveling north until the intersection of Rogers Lane, in the city of Covington in the parish of St. Tammany to be designated as "Tammany Parkway".

Directs the DOTD to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting the interstate designation.
