LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS. Designates the mayhaw fruit tree as the official state fruit tree. (8/1/14)

1 AN ACT
2 To enact R.S. 49:160.1, relative to state symbols; to provide for the official state fruit tree;
3 and to provide for related matters.
4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5 Section 1. R.S. 49:160.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
6 **§160.1. State fruit tree**
7 **There shall be an official state fruit tree. The official state fruit tree shall**
8 **be the mayhaw fruit tree. Its use on official documents of the state and with the**
9 **insignia of the state is hereby authorized.**

Proposed law provides that the mayhaw fruit tree shall be the official state fruit tree and authorizes its use on official documents of the state and with the insignia of the state.
