

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana State Law Institute identify gender
2 identifying terminology in current Louisiana law and recommend substitutions, provided that
3 the substitutions do not alter substantive meaning.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana State Law Institute report its
5 findings and recommendations to the Legislature of Louisiana prior to the convening of the
6 2015 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted
8 to the director of the Louisiana State Law Institute.
