Abstract: Creates a special prestige license plate for the Louisiana AIDS Advocacy Network (LAAN) to raise HIV/AIDS awareness.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the design and creation of special prestige license plate for HIV/AIDS awareness provided there is a minimum of 1,000 applicants.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application to any citizen of La. in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the secretary of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to work in conjunction with LAAN to select the color and design of the plate.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the department to collect an annual royalty fee of \$25 for each plate issued and specifies that such fees be collected by the department and forwarded to the LAAN. Specifies that monies received from the royalty fees shall be used solely for the support of programs administered by the LAAN. Further provides for the standard registration license fee and a handling fee of \$3.50 to be retained by the department to offset a portion of administrative costs.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary to promulgate rules and regulations to implement the provisions provided in <u>proposed law</u>.
