There is no anticipated direct material effect on local government expenditures as a result of this measure.

According to an official with the Secretary of State's Office, the office routinely budgets for up to 10 constitutional amendments for every statewide election; therefore, no additional cost to the state would likely be incurred.

This measure would allow the legislature to prepare and adopt a plan if Lafayette Parish voters approve the plan. The estimated costs involved in preparation, adoption, and election of the plan are reflected in the fiscal note for the enabling legislation, HB 980 of the 2014 Regular Legislative Session.


REVENUE EXPLANATION
