Proposed law expands the use of the award so that it may be used to fund any technical or applied course leading to an Industry Based Certification, a Certificate of Applied Sciences, and a Certificate of Technical Sciences at a Louisiana public postsecondary education institution when such certification or certificate is approved by the Workforce Investment Council as meeting the following requirements: (1) Is identified by the Occupation Forecasting Conference as a credential for an occupation in top demand in Louisiana. (2) Is recognized by the State Industry-Based Certification Council Leadership Council. Proposed law eliminates the requirement that credentials be approved by BESE and by the Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges. Proposed law eliminates the requirement that the student must have at least the minimum scores required to pass the mathematics and English portions of the graduation exit exam established by BESE. Proposed law requires that Louisiana Student Financial Aid Commission (LASFAC), rather than the Board of Regents, issue the report currently required by present law. Effective upon governor's signature.
