HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Representative Badon to Engrossed House Bill No. 347 by Representative Badon

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, delete line 11 in its entirety and insert the following:

3 "(2) As an alternate means of compliance with the requirements of 49 CFR, the
 4 owner or operator of a motor vehicle truck tractor may opt to obtain a Louisiana
 5 motor commercial motor vehicle inspection certificate which satisfies the
 6 requirements of 49 CFR 396.17. A trailer or semitrailer being used in combination
 7 with a truck tractor meeting such exemption may opt to obtain a Louisiana
 8 commercial motor vehicle inspection certificate which satisfies the requirements of
 9 49 CFR 396.17.

10 (3) As used in this Section, "commercial motor vehicle" means any self-propelled
 11 truck tractor or towed vehicle which is used on public highways to transport property
 12 in interstate commerce, has been issued an apportioned plate through the
 13 International Registration Plan; and

14 (a) Has a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) or gross combination weight rating
 15 (GCWR) of 10,001 pounds or more; or

16 (b) Is used in the transportation of hazardous materials in quantity requiring
 17 placarding under regulations issued by the secretary under the Hazardous Materials
 18 Transportation Act (49 USC app. 1801-1813)."
