1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "provide for" delete the remainder of the line and at the beginning
3 of line 3 delete "guideway" and insert in lieu thereof "fixed guideway rail"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 8, after "§214." delete "Rail fixed guideway" and insert in lieu thereof "Fixed
6 guideway rail"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 15, after "operators of" delete the remainder of the line and insert in lieu
9 thereof "fixed guideway rail"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, line 17, after "operators of" and before "systems" delete "rail fixed guideway"
12 and insert in lieu thereof "fixed guideway rail"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 1, line 18, after "safety of" delete "rail" and on line 19 after "guideway" and before
15 "systems" insert "rail"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 6

17 On page 2, line 1, after "of a" delete "rail fixed guideway" and insert in lieu thereof "fixed
18 guideway rail"

19 AMENDMENT NO. 7

20 On page 2, line 4, after "of a" delete "rail fixed guideway" and insert in lieu thereof "fixed
21 guideway rail"

22 AMENDMENT NO. 8

23 On page 2, line 5, after "of a" delete "rail fixed guideway" and insert in lieu thereof "fixed
24 guideway rail"

25 AMENDMENT NO. 9

26 On page 2, after line 6, insert the following:

27 (5) Audit, review, approve, and oversee operators of fixed guideway rail
28 systems receiving federal funds for compliance with a plan adopted by a specific
29 operator in compliance with Title 49, Section 5329(d) of the United States Code.

30 (6) Enforce statutes, regulations, executive orders, and rules relating to the
31 operation of a fixed guideway rail public transportation system in Louisiana.

1 (7) Implement such rules and regulations as may be necessary in order to
2 comply with this Section, and as may be promulgated by the Louisiana Department
3 of Transportation and Development, in accordance with the Louisiana Administrative
4 Procedure Act."
