FAMILY VIOLENCE OR NO IMPACT See Note Page 1 of 1

Provides relative to the possession, forfeiture, and seizure of firearms as it relates to persons convicted of domestic abuse battery or subject to a protective order

Present law prohibits the possession of a firearm or carrying of a concealed weapon by persons convicted of certain felony offenses. Proposed law retains present law and adds convictions of misdemeanor domestic abuse battery. Present law provides for protection from family violence and provides for services for victims of abuse and the duties of law enforcement officers regarding abuse situations. Proposed law retains present law and requires law enforcement officers to seize firearms at the scene of an act of domestic violence if they believe there could be impending danger. Proposed law provides that any person against whom the court has been issued a permanent injunction or a protective order relative to domestic abuse shall be prohibited from possessing a firearm for the duration of the injunction or protective order.

**EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. This bill limits possession of firearms or carrying of concealed weapons in certain domestic abuse situations. The only impact of adding the misdemeanor domestic abuse battery crime would be that those offenders convicted of the enumerated crimes would be prohibited from possessing firearms which would be an additional condition of parole supervision.
