1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, between lines 12 and 13, insert the following:

3	"(e)(i) For Fiscal Year 2014 -2015, for any person committed to the
4	department who is released on parole and who is subsequently arrested and
5	housed in a parish jail while awaiting a parole revocation hearing, the
6	department shall reimburse the sheriff, or to the governing authority of those
7	parishes in which the governing authority operates the parish jail, at the rate
8	of fifty percent of an amount equal to the rate provided for in the provisions
9	of Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph less the sum of any monies received
10	from the parish governing authority for the purpose of housing such persons
11	pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 13:5535(1), for each day that the person is
12	housed in the parish jail from the time of arrest until the person either pleads
13	guilty to the subsequent charge or until the committee on parole makes its
14	determination regarding parole revocation, whichever occurs first."
