SCHOOLS: Provides relative to the New Orleans Center for Creative Arts (NOCCA)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 17:1970.24(B)(1)(a)(ii)(bb), relative to the New Orleans Center
3 for Creative Arts; to provide with respect to the membership of its board of directors;
4 and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 17:1970.24(B)(1)(a)(ii)(bb) is hereby amended and reenacted to read
7 as follows:

8 §1970.24. Board of directors; creation; membership; terms; powers and duties;

Abstract: Provides relative to the membership of the board of directors of the New Orleans Center for Creative Arts.

Present law provides for the creation of the New Orleans Center for Creative Arts (NOCCA). Further provides for the creation of a board of directors to be composed of 13 members.

Present law provides that one of the members is the state superintendent of education. Proposed law replaces such member with an employee of the state Dept. of Education, appointed by the state superintendent of education; otherwise retains present law.

Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Education to the original bill.

1. Changes proposed law from authorizing a designee of the state superintendent to serve to requiring that an employee of the state Dept. of Education be appointed by the state superintendent.
