2 Louisiana University, and Walter Smith, a Southeastern Louisiana University athletic  
3 training student, assisted by retrieving the automated external defibrillator (AED); and

4           WHEREAS, Ms. Davis used the AED to provide an electrical shock in a timely  
5 manner to restart the injured spectator's heart to save his life; and

6           WHEREAS, the McNeese State University Athletic Department and its athletic  
7 training staff should be commended for flawlessly implementing its emergency action plan  
8 with essential emergency care equipment and supplies.

9           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby  
10 commend the actions of certified athletic trainers Danielle Davis and Matt Reynolds and  
11 athletic training students Shelby Michaels and Walter Smith in performing their athletic  
12 training duties to the highest standard and does hereby record for posterity their exemplary  
13 emergency responses which contributed to a life-saving rescue.
