AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 56:116.1(B)(1), relative to the taking of game birds and wild quadrupeds; to provide for the taking of game birds and wild quadrupeds from a moving land vehicle on private property; to provide certain prohibitions; to provide terms, conditions, and requirements; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 56:116.1(B)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§116.1. Wild birds and wild quadrupeds; times and methods of taking; penalties

* * *

B. No person shall do any of the following:

(1) Hunt, **shoot, or take, or attempt to hunt, shoot, or take** or take game birds or wild quadrupeds from a moving land vehicle **on public lands** or aircraft **on public lands or private property. On private property, the landowner, or his lessee or agent with written permission, may take game birds and wild quadrupeds from a moving land vehicle.**

DIGEST

Erdey (SB 662)

Present law prohibits the hunting of game birds and wild quadrupeds from a moving land vehicle.

Proposed law prohibits taking or attempting to take game birds and wild quadrupeds from a moving land vehicle on public lands but allows the taking of game birds and wild quadrupeds from a moving land vehicle on private property.

Effective August 1, 2014.
