## DIGEST

Johns (SB 556)

<u>Present law</u> provides that information on the prescribing of certain controlled dangerous substances shall be reported no longer than seven days after the date of dispensing.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends <u>present law</u> to provide each eligible prescription shall be reported no later than the next business day after the date of dispensing.

Effective August 1, 2014.

## <u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to</u> <u>the original bill</u>

1. Provides that each eligible prescription be reported no later than the next business day after the date of dispensing.
