3                   (f) The chairman of the House Committee on the

5                   (g) The chairman of the Senate Committee on Judiciary B or  
6                   his designee.

7                   (h) One district court judge with experience in criminal law  
8                   matters, selected by the president of the Louisiana District Court  
9                   Judges Association.

10                  (i) One district court judge with experience in family law  
11                  matters, selected by the president of the Louisiana District Court  
12                  Judges Association.

13                  (j) The president of the Louisiana Clerks of Court  
14                  Association or his designee.

15                  (k) One representative of the Department of Justice, office of  
16                  the attorney general or his designee.

17                  (l) The executive director of the Louisiana Commission on  
18                  Law Enforcement and Administration of Criminal Justice or his  
19                  designee.

20                  (m) The secretary of the Department of Children and Family  
21                  Services or his designee.

22                  (n) The secretary of the Department of Health and Hospitals  
23                  or his designee.

24                  (o) One representative of the Louisiana Association of  
25                  Criminal Defense Lawyers or his designee.

26                  (p) One representative of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco,  
27                  Firearms and Explosives or his designee.

28                  (2) The following two members of the commission shall be  
29                  appointed by the governor:

30                  (a) One attorney licensed to practice law in this state who has  
31                  at least five years experience in representing victims of domestic  
32                  violence who seek protective orders.

33                  (b) The executive director of a shelter-based or direct service  
34                  program provider for victims of domestic violence."
