The proposed constitutional amendment requires the state superintendent of education to be elected at the time for election

of statewide elected officials and members of the legislature in 2015. The superintendent will take office at noon on the second Monday in January 2016. The state superintendent will no longer be appointed, and the term of an appointed state superintendent of education holding office on the second Monday in January 2016, shall expire immediately before noon on that day. The superintendent will be elected for a term of four years for no more than three consecutive terms.

The constitutional amendment will be placed on the ballot at the statewide election held on November 4, 2014.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

According to the Secretary of State, there will be no additional costs for the constitutional amendment to be placed on the November 4, 2014 ballot and any future elections of the state superintendent. The elections required by the proposed legislation will occur during other statewide elections and will not generate additional election expenditures.

A companion bill (HB 127) proposes changes to the statutory provisions for this position, including salary adjustments.
