Provides for extending the collection of increased filing fees by the civil district court judges

<u>Present law</u> terminates the authority to levy additional costs and charges if public bids are not let for the construction of a facility for Civil District Court in the parish of Orleans by Aug. 15, 2014.

Proposed law retains present law but extends the termination date from Aug. 15, 2014, to Aug. 15, 2015.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation will result in an increase in local fund revenue as a result of extending filing fees (\$25 fee) associated with the judicial building fund. The proposed legislation extends the date for the Orleans Judicial District Court Building Commission to award a construction bid for a new facility which will be extended by 1 year from August 15, 2014 to August 15, 2015.

The \$25 filing fee will be collected until bids are let for construction. Under current law, once bids are let for construction, the \$25 fee will no longer be collected. However, another filing fee will be collected in the amount of \$30.

The balance of the fund as a of 12/31/13 was \$3,275,529, with annual deposits as follows: \$291,077 in 2011 (only three months were collected), \$1,462,590 in 2012, and \$1,521,862 in 2013. To extent the fee is extended for an additional year and collections remain static, the fund will collect approximately \$1.49 M (\$1,462,590 + \$1,521,862 / 2 full collection years).
