
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Civil Law and Procedure to Original House Bill No. 338 by Representative Alfred Williams

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 5, after "to" and before "declared" delete "weather, natural disasters, or"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 19, after "of" and before "a" delete "weather, natural disaster, or"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 1, line 20, after "emergency" and before the comma ", " insert "made in accordance
7 with R.S. 29:724"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 in their entirety, insert the following:

10 "force for five days after the date of issuance of the executive order declaring
11 the state of emergency. When a temporary restraining order remains in force
12 under this Paragraph, the court shall reassign the application for a
13 preliminary injunction for hearing at the earliest possible time, but no later
14 than five days after the date of issuance of the executive order declaring the
15 state of emergency. The reassignment of the application shall take
16 precedence over all matters except older matters of the same character. The
17 party who obtains a temporary restraining order shall proceed with the
18 application for a preliminary injunction when it comes on for hearing. Upon
19 his failure to do so, the court shall dissolve the temporary restraining order."
