DIGEST

Claitor (SB 633)

Proposed law provides that no public school or nonpublic school that receives any public funds may be a member of, or participate in any competition sponsored by, any interscholastic extracurricular athletic association or organization that does not provide for third-party arbitration of eligibility issues.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Education to the original bill

1. Deletes provision requiring a school receiving public funds to submit a budget of revenue and expenses of its interscholastic extracurricular program to the Dept. of Education annually.
